

CBE Citation Style for Articles from Newspapers

The citations of a **References** page should be listed alphabetically and formatted with single-spacing and *hanging indents*. (The first line of each citation is at the left margin. All subsequent lines are indented one-half inch from the left margin.) To create hanging indents, consult the Help feature of your word processing program. The Tab key may also be used. In most word processing programs, it is pre-set to indent the required one-half inch.

➤ **Newspaper article from a hardcopy newspaper (print, microfilm, or microfiche)**

Needed information - Author's last name first initial middle initial (if available). Date of Publication. Title of the article. Title of Newspaper;Sect section designator:page number(column number).

Examples

Kolata G. 2003 Feb 15. First mammal clone dies. New York Times;Sect A:4.

Hurwit J. 2002 July 26. Faces of faith. Washington Post;Sect B:4(col 5).

➤ **Newspaper article from an online newspaper**

Needed information - Author's last name first initial middle initial (if available). Date of Publication. Title of the article. Title of Newspaper [serial online]. Available from: URL. Accessed Year Month Day.

Example

Scruggs RJ. 2002 Jan 27. Rabies' second wave has begun. Sun Journal [serial online]. Available from: <http://www.sunjournal.com/story.asp?slg=012702rabies>. Accessed 2002 May 5.

➤ **Full-text newspaper article from a database**

Needed information - Author's last name first initial middle initial (if available). Date of Publication. Title of the article. Title of Newspaper [serial online];Sect section designator:page number. Available from: Database Name(Article's Accession Number, if available). Accessed Year Month Day.

Example

Eisinger J. 2002 Sep 9. Ahead of the tape. Wall Street Journal [serial online];Sect C:1. Available from: ProQuest Newspapers(163518271). Accessed 2002 Nov 15.

➤ **Newspaper article with no author**

Place [Anonymous] in the author position.

Example

[Anonymous]. 2003 July 31. New drug cuts risk of death from heart attack. The Washington Post;Sect A:12(col 2).

➤ **Newspaper article with multiple authors** (Use these formats to replace single author names in the above examples.)

Two authors - Rogers MA, King C.

Three authors - Edwards C, Nadar LS, Brown P.

More than three authors - List them all. Follow the style for *Three authors* above.
